English

This half term our focus is writing fact files and recounts. The children will use non-fiction books to research and learn about different continents.

Children will be learning to; Compose and write sentences independently.

Punctuate sentences correctly, including capital letters for names and places.

Use phonic knowledge to write unfamiliar words.

Mathematics

We will:

Read, write, count and order numbers to 100.

Count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

Recall addition and subtraction facts for numbers up to 20.

Compare and describe the weight and volume of familiar items.

Understand and use terms and vocabulary associated with position, direction and movement.

Our Learning Challenge question is 'Where in the world our we?'

To launch this topic will be visiting The Birmingham Sea Life Centre to explore and discover the range of climates and animals from around the world.



We will be using maps and globes to locate the arctic regions and the continents using geographical language. We will compare climates such as Antarctica and Africa.

We will use a range of painting techniques to re-create the Northern Lights.

We will be creating a travel agents role play area.
